### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION


Welcome to the 2014 School Year at Our Lady of the Rosary. We look forward to working with your child/ren as together we grow in faith and love of God, as we follow in the footsteps of Jesus.

### THE FEAST DAY OF ST JOHN BOSCO 31st January

Last Friday we started the day with prayer and scripture as we remembered the Feast Day of St John Bosco, who was the founder of the Salesian order of Priests and Brothers. As you know our parish has a very strong connection with the Salesians. Fr Brendan Murphy is our Parish Priest and Fr Jerry Brean and Fr Guy Riolo are our Assistant Priests. We thank God for their pastoral care and leadership of our faith community, given so generously by all the Salesians who serve with such commitment in our Parish Community.

St John Bosco was the youngest son of a peasant farmer in the town of Turin, Northern Italy. Soon after his ordination in 1841 he began his life's work of educating poor and orphaned children. He had an extraordinary gift for handling difficult youths without punishment, but with gentle and effective firmness.

Inspired by St Francis de Sales, Don Bosco called his helpers "Salesians", who were formally recognized by the church in 1874.

First Reading Phil 4:4-9

A reading from the letter of St Paul to the Philippians

Fill your minds with everything that is holy.

I want you to be happy, always happy in the Lord; I repeat, what I want is your happiness. Let your tolerance be evident to everyone: the Lord is very near. There is no need to worry; but if there is anything you need, pray for it, asking God for it with prayer and thanksgiving, and that peace of God, which is so much greater than we can understand, will guard your hearts and your thoughts, in Christ Jesus. Finally, brothers, fill your minds with everything that is true, everything that is noble, everything that is good and pure, everything that we love and honour, and everything that can be thought virtuous or worthy of praise. Keep doing all the things that you learnt from me and have been taught by me and have heard or seen that I do. Then the God of peace will be with you.


